

Job Description

Civic Disability Services is a not-for-profit organisation that provides services to individuals with intellectual disability and mental illness. We aim to create a society where people have the opportunity to realise their full potential, achieve their goals and participate as a valued member of the community.

Role: Occupational Therapist

Reporting: The role reports to Clinical Practice Manager

Objective:

The key objectives of the role are to:

- 1. To provide occupational therapy services to the people supported by Civic Disability Services to promote positive mental, physical and emotional health; social and economic participation.
- 2. Maintain or maximise a client's independence in the areas of self-care, work and leisure.

Duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Use a multi-disciplinary approach to assist clients to meet their needs, goals, objectives and aspirations.
- 2. Adopt a Person-Centred Approach with all client and stakeholder interactions.
- 3. Assess and coordinate the delivery of occupational therapy services to children and adults with physical, intellectual and/or psychosocial disabilities.
- 4. Assess, recommend and prescribe equipment and modifications to improve a client's environment or performance of a task.
- 5. Assess, recommend and produce comprehensive functional assessment reports in relation to an individual's suitability to access alternative housing options (e.g. Supported Independent Living and Specialist Disability Accommodation).
- 6. Conduct home visits and visits to the community as required.
- 7. Investigate and source skill building and independent living resources.
- 8. Develop and deliver training on equipment specific protocols, procedures, practices and/or evidence-based interventions to team members and carers to improve their skills and knowledge, meet a client's needs and support methods, and improve client outcomes.
- 9. Develop and deliver training modules in relation to safe work practices such as Manual Handling.
- 10. Advise the Manager of any significant changes or concerns regarding a client, their home environment, wellbeing, their services, or other risks, as soon as possible
- 11. Utilise a referral-based service model.
- 12. Appropriately use technology and equipment supplied to effectively complete work tasks.

- 13. Plan and organise a daily personal work routine which facilitates completion of allocated work tasks.
- 14. Develop and maintain appropriate and accurate records, reports and documentation, including electronic records for person we support.
- 15. Actively participate in the work environment and engage in personal/professional development opportunities.
- 16. Follow procedures established within the Organisation including Occupational Health and Safety Policies, Procedures and Instructions of the Organisation.
- 17. Any other duties as directed by the Clinical Services Manager within the scope of the position and competence of the employee concerned.

Essential Criteria

- Degree qualified in Occupational Therapy.
- Current, unrestricted registration as an Occupational Therapist with AHPRA.
- Experience undertaking evidenced based clinical assessments and providing therapeutic interventions to meet client needs.
- Experience in sensory processing, complex seating and home modifications would be a huge advantage.
- Experience in a community health and/or disability services environment with a focus on people with complex care needs would be a huge advantage.
- An understanding of the National Disability Insurance Scheme and the Quality and Safeguarding Commission would be a huge advantage.
- The ability to translate sometimes complex clinical concepts, policy and legislative requirements into a language and format that clients, employees and other stakeholders can understand and use.
- The ability to form working relationships based on trust and respect, where internal customers see the value of the services you provide.
- A passion for working with clients, colleagues, families and others to find innovative and practical solutions that allow clients to realise their human potential.
