Visit Port Kembla Heritage Park and meander through the cement pyramids which were anti-tank barriers used as wartime defences. The Breakwater Battery Military Museum is open on the 2nd or 4th Sunday of the month.

Learn about the lifesaving work the park does through its antivenom program and important conservation work.

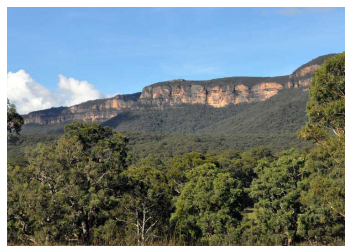
